#### **Didactics:**

5 hours per week is dedicated to didactic activities at the primary site (site 1)

#### Vacation:

PGY1 – Three (3) calendar weeks (inclusive of weekends, a maximum of 15 weekdays) is allowed. May be taken in a maximum of 7 consecutive days. Should be taken during Inpatient Psychiatry rotation.

PGY2 and above – Four (4) calendar weeks (inclusive of weekends, a maximum of 20 weekdays) is allowed. May be taken in a maximum of 7 consecutive days. May be taken during any rotation.

May include research, administrative psychiatry, addiction psychiatry, geriatric psychiatry, partial hospitalization program, forensics, and other external rotations.
