

Campbell & Kesseler

Rooms are air-conditioned (not below 73 degrees) and include 4 individual bedrooms with an XL twin bed and 2-bathroom suite. There is no university furniture in the shared common area.

Linens are not provided. Please bring XL twin or queen sheets, pillows, blankets, and/or sleeping bags. We recommend bringing fans to stay cool.

Check-In | July 21, 12:00 - 4:00 p.m.

When you arrive, leave your belongings in your vehicle, enter the Kesseler Hall main entrance, and head to the center desk in the Towers to see the Camps and Conference staff. Here you'll receive your room assignment, key, and access card. Move-in will run from 12:00 - 4:00 p.m. Individuals arriving outside of the timeframes listed below may check-in with the Camps and Conference Staff by calling 989-774-6748

Check-Out | July 23, 12:00 p.m.

Remove all of your belongings from your room and take trash/recycling to dumpsters (your desk can help you find this location) Don't forget to return your key to the front desk. All rooms must be cleared by noon on Sunday, July 23. Lost keys are \$100.00 per key.

- You will get a key card on a lanyard. Please keep your key card on you at all times during the weekend. Be sure not to lose it!
- Your key card will allow you access to the exterior doors when the building is locked.
- You may keep the key card and lanyard as a souvenir!
- · Additional toilet paper and trash bags can be picked up from the front desk.
- Individuals who are 21+ may drink in their room. Alcohol is not permitted in public spaces of the residence halls and hallways.
- Door Decoration Rules: Please ensure there is not lewd images/messaging/language on door decs or decorations on the floor. Decorations can not be hung from any pipes in the rooms or hallways. Door decorations should not cover the peep hole. Door decorations need to leave space at the top and bottom of the door for fire safety. Decorations can not cover lights. Decorations can not be hung from sprinklers. Decorations can not be hung with permanent fixtures.




