Selection Criteria

The awards will be determined by a member of the CLASS Scholarship Selection Committee based upon the following:

- 1) Admission to Central Michigan University as an incoming freshman for the fall semester
- 2) Primary residence in the state of Michigan
- 3) High School GPA and ACT score meet the minimum scholarship requirements
- 4) Expressed intent of majoring in one of the academic majors in the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences
- 5) Preference will be given to applicants with financial need. To demonstrate financial need applicants should submit a **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.ed.gov).**
- 6) A one-page essay indicating what area you intend to major in and why, as well as why you are deserving of this scholarship
- 7) A letter of recommendation from a High School teacher
