

## **Recomputation of Grade Point Average (GPA) Request Form**

Students who change from one graduate program to another may file a Recomputation of GPA. The Recomputation of GPA request must be filed within one calendar year of beginning the new program.

I understand the following implications of an approved and processed recomputation of GPA:

- A recomputation of GPA cannot be reversed
- All coursework completed on my original graduate program will remain on my transcript but will not be used when calculating my cumulative graduate GPA and may not be accepted as transfer credit by other institutions
- My financial aid eligibility will still take into account ALL my previous credits
