Course Description:

"Statistics is a language for communicating what we can learn from data," according to a past president of the Royal Statistical Society, Deborah Ashby. For many physicians, this 'foreign language' is clarified by engaging with a statistician to analyze data and explain the results of a research project. Understanding the importance of phrases such as "intention to treat" or "power" in research involves giving the statistician the understanding of a project. By working well with a statistician, a researcher can provide honest, trustworthy new information to their medical colleagues.
