Course Description:

An abstract is defined as a self-contained, short, powerful statement describing a larger body of work. Some authors describe it as the most important paragraph of a research project. Many research projects are not published due to the poor manuscript and not due to the lack of merit of the discovery being shared. Writing a concise, clear summary of scholarly work can be guided by some basic principles which will be described here.
