Course Description:

As researchers, we sometimes struggle with writing and think if only we could wave a magic wand! Such a wand is not easily accessible unless one is an alumnus of Hogwarts! However, AI is a potential resource for writers that in recent years is attracting great attention. There are critical issues that its use may promote and reproduce bias and increase plagiarism and also hopes for its potential such as democratizing publishing through free language editing. Skills & strategies are needed to navigate the fast-changing environment that includes GenAI.

This presentation will be a hands-on experience. It will present my experiments with ChatGPT as a writing tool through interactive participatory demonstration to illustrate the value of prompts and capabilities of ChatGPT. Discuss if ChatGPT can be used ethically to support and improve the scholarly writing process and product and some existing ethical concerns.
