Clinical Description

Each course listed above is designed to engage teacher candidates in understanding how to incorporate specials (art, physical education, health and music) content into the classroom. The clinical will be in an approved after-school setting, allowing teacher candidates to also experience students in this unique setting after the traditional school day. Teacher candidates will practice lesson planning/design and engaging students in a lesson that includes the specials content specific to the course.
