Clinical Description

As part of CMU's cohesive sequence of clinical experiences, this course will include 110+ hours of student contact in a PK-12 educational setting. Student contact hours might include time working directly with students as well as instructional planning with a mentor teacher. Student contact experiences will gradually increase to include greater responsibility for instructional delivery and student learning. These clinical hours will help the candidate fulfil the Michigan Department of Education requirement for 600 clinical hours in initial preparation.

Clinical Placement General Information

12-week placement within grades PK- 6 in a partnership school with a location within a 60-mile radius of CMU. Placement days are listed in course registration for each course section. When the EDU 380 course section is scheduled on Monday, placement is on Wednesday. When the EDU 380 course section is scheduled on Tuesday, placement is on Thursday. Option B* 12-week placement within grades PK- 6 in a partnership school with a location within a 60-mile radius of the candidate's community college.
