

Richard Kirchner Scholarship

Application Deadline: Friday, March 21, 2025

Description:

The Richard Kirchner Scholarship was established in honor of Dr. Dick Kirchner, who was the Department's first chairperson from 1956-1992. Dr. Kirchner's visionary leadership led to our programs' concentrations, national accreditation, and the first recreation minor in the U.S.

Award:

Three awards in the amount of \$3,000.00 will be given annually to undergraduate students majoring in RPL. Consideration will be given to the awarding of scholarship per program, but only if there are equally qualified candidates.

Eligibility Factors:

- 1. Completion of eight hours of RPL coursework
- 2. Signed RPL major
- 3. 3.0 overall GPA in RPL coursework
- 4. Students may only apply for the DOYLE or the KIRCHNER, in an academic year, NOT BOTH

Procedure:

- 1. The following materials must be:

- d. Copy of student transcripts (does not have to be an official copy)
- e. Work / service reference (cannot be an RPL professor)
- 2. All applications that are received by the designated deadline will be evaluated by the faculty review committee to determine eligibility for interviewing.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of the selection process results no sooner than 30 days after the submission deadline.

Criteria Used for Evaluation:

- 1. Materials must be completed and presented in a professional manner.
- 2. Demonstrated leadership in RPL through any of the following: practical experience, community service/volunteerism, professional development experiences.
- 3. Demonstrated quality in academic performance.
- 4. Develop philosophical perspective on the value of academic preparation and recreation/leisure to individual, communities and society.
- 5. Work / services reference, with original signature, preferably from a recreation facility/program.
