# **Description:**

The Detective John S. Nagy, Sr. Scholarship was established by Drs. Robert and Dale-Elizabeth Pehrsson. The recipient of this award must be a first-generation college student who has financial need and wishes to serve and make a better society by engaging in the professional work that promotes natural resources and educates our youth about the natural environments. This scholarship will be geared toward young professionals who desire to help our citizens enjoy a lifetime of activity, balance, sustainability and productivity.

### Award:

One award in the amount of \$750.00 will be given annually to an undergraduate student who meets the following.

#### **Eligibility Factors:**

- 1. First generation college student preferred not required
- 2. Any RPL major; preferred interest in natural resources
- 3. 3.0 overall GPA
- 4. Sophomore, Junior or Senior status

### Procedure:

- e. Work / service reference (cannot be from an RPL professor)
- 2. All applications that are received by the designated deadline will be evaluated by the faculty review committee to determine eligibility for interviewing.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of the selection process results no sooner than 30 days after the submission deadline.

### **Criteria Used for Evaluation:**

- 1. Materials must be completed and presented in a professional manner.
- 2. Demonstrated leadership in RPL through any of the following: practical experience, community service/volunteerism, professional development experiences.
- 3. Demonstrated focus on career-minded goals and objectives.
- 4. Work / services references, with original signatures.
