BACKGROUND: ARC-PA Standard A3.13c states: *The program must define, publish, consistently apply and make readily available to prospective students, policies and procedures to include:*

c) practices for awarding or granting advanced placement.

PURPOSE:

To ensure compliance with ARC-PA standard A3.13c, the CMU PA program will clearly define and publish the policy related to practices for awarding or granting advanced placement.

POLICY:

The CMU PA Program curriculum has been purposefully designed in a stepwise fashion to ensure fundamental medical knowledge is established and appropriately built upon. CMU PA Program students must complete all required courses in the specific sequence they are offered. No transfer of credit from other medical or PA programs will be allowed to complete and/or substitute for any required course in the CMU PA Program curriculum. Furthermore, no advanced placement will be allowed for any student to fulfil any course in the CMU PA Program curriculum.
