

2025 Award for Outstanding Service

The College of Science & Engineering Outstanding Service Award recognizes exceptional service to the college, university, profession, or public.

Eligibility

CSE faculty, staff, and students (including Registered Student Organizations) are eligible for this award. Individuals or groups may be nominated multiple times but only receive this award once every ten years.

Criteria for Selection

- Demonstrable impact in supporting and sustaining the quality and effectiveness of an organization or a community. Generally, the impact will result from the application of the awardee's professional expertise, although exceptions are possible.
- Demonstrated initiative, commitment, and leadership in accomplishing the above.
 Evidence may include, but is not limited to, creating a new process or program (or revitalizing an existing one), substantial engagement over a sustained period, and engaging others.

Nomination and Application Process

- Nomination process
 - Nominations should describe why and how the nominee merits special recognition given the criteria above (maximum of one page). Self-nominations and nominations from colleagues, students, and alumni are encouraged.
 - Nominations must be received by the College of Science & Engineering Dean's office by Monday, April 7, 5:00 pm, here or via email to tycne1c@cmich.edu.
- Application process
 - Nominees will be asked to provide the following information:
 - A narrative that describes how the nominee meets the criteria for selection with specific examples. The description should include how the service has significantly impacted the relevant organization or community.
 - Any additional evidence that supports the nominee's application.
 - The application should be a maximum of three pages and exclusive of the nomination.
 - Applications must be received by the College of Science & Engineering Dean's office by Friday, May 2, 5:00 pm, via email to tycne1c@cmich.edu.
