This scholarship supports a one-week workshop at Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts in Gatlinburg, Tennessee. As a Windgate Fellow. As as fellow, you receive a one-week workshop of their choice (dependent of availability), plus a \$300 stipend (paid at workshop conclusion) to help offset material fees and travel costs. Students receive complimentary dorm housing (4-13 beds per room) in the Red Barn but can upgrade their selection for an additional fee; to be paid at time of registration by the student. The award recipient is responsible for travel planning and travel costs to and from the school. The award recipient is responsible for materials. At the conclusion of the workshop, students are asked to write a testimonial and provide a photograph from their time at Arrowmont. This will be shared with the Windgate Foundation as a thank you for funding this opportunity.

BS ED VISUAL ART EDUCATION MAJORS: Portfolio of 2–5 images of creative work and 1–2 written assignments: These may include mid-term or final exams, written assignments, research papers, or lesson plans. Each example must be identified with the course that it was completed in (if applicable) and the date of completion. Please submit all written assignments and images/examples of your creative work as a single PDF. Each image must be clearly identified with the title of work, the course that it was completed in (if applicable), date of completion, medium, and dimensions.
