Persistence & Graduation Rates of CMU Overall First-Time Freshmen

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Introduction

The Office of Academic Planning & Analysis conducts an on-going study of persistence and graduation rates of overall undergraduate students at Central Michigan University. This report includes a summary of the results along with tables that present the persistence and graduation rates for first-time freshmen students. The tables present data on overall persistence and graduation rates, as well as rates broken down by students' gender and ethnicity.

For this study, a student is defined as having persisted into a given semester if he or she attended CMU during that semester or had previously graduated from CMU with a baccalaureate degree. Non-persisters include transfers (students who have transferred to other colleges/universities), stop outs (those who have dropped out temporarily and who will return to college in the future), and dropouts (those who no longer will continue with their education).

Summary

This report contains information about the persistence and graduation rates of Central Michigan University first-time freshmen entering CMU in the fall semesters between 2009 and 2019.

The major findings over the most recent three cohort years, on average, are:

- About 76.1% of first-time freshmen entering CMU in the fall semester began their second year at CMU.
- Female students have higher second-year persistence rates (77.3%) on average than Male students (73.3%).
- Second-year persistence rates by ethnicity are:
 - Nonresident Alien (81.9%)
 - Hispanic/Latino (72.5%)
 - American Indian or Alaska Native (58.2%)
 - Asian/Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander Students (75.1%)
 - Black or African American (69.7%)
 - White (77.4%)
 - Two or more races (68.3%)
 - Race and Ethnicity unknown (82.4%)
- Of a typical first-time freshman class, 60.9% graduate from CMU with a bachelor's degree within seven years. Also, 33.9% graduate in four years or less, 56.5% graduate in five years or less, and 61.5% graduate in six years or less.
- Female students graduate within seven years at a higher rate (64.2%) on average than Male students (56.9%).
- Seven-year graduation rates by ethnicity are:
 - Nonresident Alien (57.9%)
 - Hispanic/Latino (50.1%)
 - American Indian or Alaska Native (59.9%)
 - o Asian/Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander Students (63.8%)

- o Black or African American (44.5%)
- o White (63.6%)
- o Two or more races (44.0%)
- o Race and Ethnicity unknown (57.7%)

Persistence & Graduation Rates of CMU On-Campus First-Time Freshmen

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Introduction

The Office of Academic Planning & Analysis conducts an on-going study of persistence and graduation rates of On-campus enrolled undergraduate students at Central Michigan University. This report includes a summary of the results along with tables that present the persistence and graduation rates for first-time freshmen students. The tables present data about on-campus persistence and graduation rates, as well as rates broken down by students' gender and ethnicity.

For this study, a student is defined as having persisted into a given semester if he or she attended CMU during that semester or had previously graduated from CMU with a baccalaureate degree. Non-persisters include transfers (students who have transferred to other colleges/universities), stop outs (those who have dropped out temporarily and who will return to college in the future), and dropouts (those who no longer will continue with their education).

Summary

This report contains information about the persistence and graduation rates of Central Michigan University first-time freshmen entering CMU in the fall semesters between 2009 and 2019.

The major findings over the most recent three cohort years, on average, are:

- About 76.1% of first-time freshmen entering CMU in the fall semester began their second year at CMU.
- Female students have higher second-year persistence rates (78.0%) on average than Male students (73.6%).
- Second-year persistence rates by ethnicity are:
 - Nonresident Alien (81.9%)
 - Hispanic/Latino (72.5%)
 - American Indian or Alaska Native (57.3%)
 - Asian/Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (75.6%)
 - Black or African American (70.3%)
 - White (77.8%)
 - Two or more races (68.8%)
 - Race and ethnicity unknown (82.4%)
- Of a typical first-time freshman class, 61.7% graduate from CMU with a bachelor's degree within seven years. Also, 34.3% graduate in four years or less, 57.2% graduate in five years or less, and 62.1% graduate in six years or less.
- Female students graduate within seven years at a higher rate (64.9%) on average than Male students (57.2%).
- Seven-year graduation rates by ethnicity are:
 - Nonresident Alien (59.9%)
 - Hispanic/Latino (51.1%)
 - American Indian or Alaska Native (59.9%)
 - Asian/Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (65.3%)
 - Black or African American (49.1%)

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- 2. Summary
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Introduction

The Office of Academic Planning & Analysis conducts an on-going study of persistence and graduation rates of global-campus undergraduate students, who did not enroll on-campus at Central Michigan University. This report includes a summary of the results along with tables that present the persistence and graduation rates for first-time freshmen students. The tables present data on global campus persistence and graduation rates, as well as rates broken down by students' gender and ethnicity.

For this study, a student is defined as having persisted into a given semester if he or she attended CMU during that semester or had previously graduated from CMU with a baccalaureate degree. Non-persisters include transfers (students who have transferred to other colleges/universities), stop outs (those who have dropped out temporarily and who will return to college in the future), and dropouts (those who no longer will continue with their education).

Summary

This report contains information about the persistence and graduation rates of Central Michigan University first-time freshmen entering CMU in the fall semesters between 2009 and 2019.

The major findings over the most recent three cohort years, on average, are:

- About 44.6% of first-time freshmen entering CMU in the fall semester began their second year at CMU.
- Male students have higher second-year persistence rates (40.6%) on average than Female students (37.9%).
- Second-year persistence rates by ethnicity, in ascending order are:
 - Black or African American (22.9%)
 - o White (51.4%)
- Of a typical first-time freshman class, 7.5% graduate from CMU with a bachelor's degree within seven years. Also, 1.9% graduate in four years or less, 3.7% graduate in five years or less, and 4.1% graduate in six years or less.
- Female students graduate within seven years at a lower rate (6.6%) on average than Male students (9.2%).
- Seven-year graduation rates by ethnicity, in ascending order are:
 - Black or African American (3.8%)
 - o White (15.2%)
