SUBJECT: SELECTION OF HONORARY DEGREE CANDIDATES

Candidates for the Honorary Degree may be nominated by any person. These nominations, along with whatever documentary evidence is available and/or further group or individual recommendations can be made to the Academic Senate Liaison Committee. For the purpose of recommending recipients of Honorary Degrees, two students, elected by the Academic Senate, will be added to the Liaison Committee. The Liaison Committee in turn shall pass these recommendations on to the Board of Trustees. The responsibility, by law, for the granting of Honorary Degrees remains the responsibility of the Board of Trustees.
